

In order to position ourselves to receive healing through faith, we must answer this question: What knowledge must the sick accumulate in order to position themselves properly to receive healing?

Consider this phrase closely: Teach the God-side first, then teach the man-side; it makes the man-side easier.

1. Lets talk about our heavenly Father's point on Love. Notice what Jesus said in this scripture. Please look at this phrase, "As I have Loved You". This implies that if we have not been taught how He loves us, then our ability to obey this commandment is limited. Knowledge must precede compliance. Joh 13:34
2. Another example that will bring an understanding is when the Gospel of Salvation is preached to the lost. When we proclaim the truths of the cross and how one can obtain forgiveness we are declaring the God-side of salvation. Then the man-side is easier for the lost to execute the instructions found in the scriptures. The more God-side information a person has, the easier it becomes to do what God expects of him. Rom 10:9-10
3. When it comes to obtaining healing by faith, there is a certain position that we must be in. Believing we receive when we pray is the position we must be in if we desire to be healed by faith. Mar 11:24
4. When it comes to healing there are certain things that we MUST come to know about our Heavenly Father. The fact that people have not failed to receive healing because they do not believe. Rather, failure has come in many cases because they do not believe what they MUST believe. In order to become born again there are certain things we must believe. These things are a MUST, that God raised Jesus from the dead. The lost cannot believe what they want to believe, they must believe in specific things about God! Rom 10:9
5. In life there are "should issues" and there are "must issues". We should wash our cars, but we must put gas in it. We should exercise, but we must eat. Likewise there are things we should believe in and there are things we MUST believe in order to receive healing! Heb 11:6
6. Once you met the conditions to be saved, you believed, "He is". The moment you believed that it is God's will for you to be healed, you met one of the conditions for pleasing Him. Once you believe that "He is" the healer, you realize He is a rewarder. Now you are on the journey toward believing that you receive when you pray. Heb 11:6
7. We must believe that God is a "giver" if we do not believe this how can we expect to receive what we have need of? Jam 1:5-7
8. God is a giver! Since God loved us to the degree that He sacrificed His Son for us, how could we ever imagine God saying NO to us when we approach Him for healing? Rom 8:32
9. Apostle Paul knew the Lord and said God is ready to give to us when we ask. 2Cor 1:20

10. Once we believe that our Heavenly Father is a liberal, free, and rich giver, there will be doubts that do arise that will question whether or not God is indeed a giver. When these doubts arise, we vocalize our beliefs by what we KNOW about our giving Heavenly Father! Doing so will cause those doubts to back off, and we will find that it becomes easy to remain loyal to our belief that God is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
11. What does God give the sick? He always gives “anointing”, anointing oil, Mar 16:18
the name of Jesus, healing cloths, the spoken word, the prayer of faith and the laying
on of hands.
12. What does God give the sick when hands are laid on them? He gives them healing Mar 11:24
power! The instant we pray or hands laid upon us, the healing pwer of God is
administered to our body. Therefore, after we pray we can confidently proclaim that
we believe that we have received. Our bold confession is not based on what I see or feel.
Rather our confession is based on the solid foundation that it is God’s will for us to
be healed. He is a liberal giver of healing power.
13. Believing made simple. Remaining in the belief that we received when we prayed Luk 4:1-13
demands that every thought and suggestion about the outcome be scrutinized and
examined. Any thought that questions whether or not we received must be responded
to immediatly. Failure to do so could result in the entertainment of thoughts that
would eventually cause you to drift away from believing that we received or
denounce the belief all together. We must speak out loud to the devil same as
what Jesus did!
14. to maintain that what God has given to us is to thank Him constantly. We are grateful for making us
aware that it is His will to heal. We are grateful that He is a giver. We are grateful that the laying on of
hands has healed us. We are grateful that he gave us healing power!

Once that the power is administered, the only thing left to do is give thanks. For thanksgiving is the polite thing to do once we realize that something has been given to us!
