- **Declare the power of the blood of Jesus**
  - The blood of Jesus cleanses us from all sin.
  - Forgive lest you be snared by the devil
  - You are dead in Christ & risen with Him in heavenly places
  
- **Command down the lust of the flesh, eyes & pride of life**
  - These snares are to bow to the manifold wisdom of God
  - Pull down strongholds in Jesus name.
  - Command down imaginations in Jesus name.
  - Command down high things in Jesus name.
  
- **Break the power of the enemy**
  - Every word that has risen up against you.
  - Command condemnation on the words in Jesus name.
  - The words have no effect on you.
  - You are loosed from the words
  - The curse causeless has no advantage of you in Jesus name.
  - Bind the devil by the power of the Holy Spirit in Jesus name.
  - The devil has no authority and is commanded to loose & shut up.
  
- **Pray in tongues to hear from God. Get interpretation from the Lord.**
  
- **Our Father which art in Heaven, Hallowed be thy name.**
  - Praise & Adore God
  - **Ps 61:1-2** Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer.
  - From the end of the earth will I cry unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed: lead me to the rock that is higher than I.
  - **Ps 100** make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands.
  - Serve the Lord with gladness: come before his presence with singing.
  - Know ye that the Lord he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.
  - Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.

- **Ps 62:5-8** My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from him. 6 He only is my rock and my salvation: he is my defence; I shall not be moved. 7 In God is my salvation and my glory: the rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in God. 8 Trust in him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us. KJV

  - **Ps 27:4** One thing have I desired of the Lord, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in his temple.
  - **Ps 27:11** Teach me thy way, O Lord, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.
- **Give us this day our daily bread.**
    - My God is my source
    - Ps 31:24 Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the Lord.
    - My God supplies all my needs in Christ Jesus.
    - **Ps 34:8-10** O taste and see that the Lord is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him. 9 O fear the Lord, ye his saints: for there is no want to them that fear him. 10 The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the Lord shall not want any good thing.
    - God's will is to prosper me in everything I set my hand to.
    - I make my God happy by being prosperous – I rejoice.
    - **Ps 118:24-25** This is the day which the Lord hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. 25 Save now, I beseech thee, O Lord: O Lord, I beseech thee, send now prosperity.
    - I'm seeking God's righteousness, thus he is adding to me daily
    - **Ps 37:23-25** The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord: and he delighteth in his way. 24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the Lord upholdeth him with his hand. 25 I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.
    - **Ps 68:19** Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation.
  - **And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.**
    - **Ps 61:1-2** Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer.
    - 2 From the end of the earth will I cry unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed: lead me to the rock that is higher than I.
    - I forgive and release others.
    - **Ps 51:7-17** Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. 8 Make me to hear joy and gladness; that the bones which thou hast broken may rejoice. 9 Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities.

- 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. 11 Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me. 12 Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit. 13 Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee. 14 Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, thou God of my salvation: and my tongue shall sing aloud of thy righteousness. 15 O Lord, open thou my lips; and my mouth shall shew forth thy praise. 16 For thou desirest not sacrifice; else would I give it: thou delightest not in burnt offering. 17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.
- If we confess our sins He is just and faithful to forgive us our sins.
- We forgive even when we have not done anything wrong, so the devil does not take advantage of us.
- Ask God to forgive you.
- **Ps 51:1-3** Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions. 2 Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. 3 For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me.
- Receive your forgiveness by the blood of Jesus Christ our Lord.
- **Ps 66:12** Thou hast caused men to ride over our heads; we went through fire and through water: but thou broughtest us out into a wealthy place.

- **And Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.**

- Declare the power of the blood
- **Ps 55:22** Cast thy burden upon the Lord, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.
- Loose yourself and get your spirit in tune with God
- Put on the armor of God
- Bind the devil by the power of the Holy Spirit
- Command the devil to go and to loose you, your family and loved ones in Jesus name
- The same power that raised Jesus from the dead lives in me!
- We have been given authority over the devil and command him to go
- **Ps 64** Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy. 2 Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the workers of iniquity:

- 3 Who whet their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows, even bitter words: 4 That they may shoot in secret at the perfect: suddenly do they shoot at him, and fear not. 5 They encourage themselves in an evil matter: they commune of laying snares privily; they say, Who shall see them? 6 They search out iniquities; they accomplish a diligent search: both the inward thought of every one of them, and the heart, is deep. 7 But God shall shoot at them with an arrow; suddenly shall they be wounded. 8 So they shall make their own tongue to fall upon themselves: all that see them shall flee away.
- 9 And all men shall fear, and shall declare the work of God; for they shall wisely consider of his doing. 10 The righteous shall be glad in the Lord, and shall trust in him; and all the upright in heart shall glory.
- **Ps 68:1** Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered: let them also that hate him flee before him.
  
- **For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory for ever.**
  - **Ps 91:1-2** He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. 2 I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.
  - End with praise
  - Adoration to God
  - **Ps 95:1-3** come, let us sing unto the Lord: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. 2 Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms. 3 For the Lord is a great God, and a great King above all gods.
  - **Ps 96** O sing unto the Lord a new song: sing unto the Lord, all the earth.
  - 2 Sing unto the Lord, bless his name; shew forth his salvation from day to day. 3 Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people.
  - 4 For the Lord is great, and greatly to be praised: he is to be feared above all gods. 5 For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the Lord made the heavens. 6 Honour and majesty are before him: strength and beauty are in his sanctuary. 7 Give unto the Lord, O ye kindreds of the people, give unto the Lord glory and strength. 8 Give unto the Lord the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts. 9 O worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth. 10 Say among the heathen that the Lord reigneth: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved: he shall judge the people righteously. 11 Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof. 12 Let the field be joyful, and all that is therein: then shall all the trees of the wood rejoice 13 Before the Lord: for he cometh, for he cometh

to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth. KJV
